

Why assess listening?


- Better listeners make better readers.

Is There a Lexile Scale That Measures Listening?


Yes! The Lexile scale measures both the English listening ability level of the student and the difficulty of audio materials. Students can be matched to audio materials that are just right.

Audio passages are analyzed by the <i>Lexile</i> ® Audio Analyzer. This tool evaluates the vocabulary, grammar, word sounds and delivery to assess audio complexity.	Students get Lexile measures by taking a listening test that is linked to the Lexile scale. Test items assess students' understanding of the main idea, their ability to recall specific details, and their ability to make inferences.	Teachers get a better understanding of a student's literacy skills with both listening and reading test results. Students can connect with audio materials that are targeted to their listening ability.
